As a member of World Overcomers, you will receive the following Benefits:

3. Premarital Counseling/Wedding Ceremonies
4. Funeral Services
5. Convalescent Support
6. Benevolence

In the pages to follow, we will address each of these steps and give you the tools you need to become a fully-functioning member of World Overcomers.

This New Members handbook is an outline of the expectations between you as a new member and World Overcomers Christian Church.

1. Receive Salvation/Become a Born Again Believer

World Overcomers is a local body of believers that is a part of the universal body of Christ. In order to be a part of the body a person must be saved and identify with Christ- meaning they have accepted Jesus Christ as their personal Lord and Savior. As such, to be a member of our church we require that you be a saved, born again believer, who has expressed faith and repentance in the Lord Jesus Christ.

2. Receive Water Baptism

Water baptism is very important. We are commanded in the Scriptures to be baptized (*Acts 2:38*). Being baptized is the first thing you should do after repentance. By faith, you are identifying totally with the burial and resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ. In baptism, you are testifying to God, to demons, to the world, and to yourself (a four-fold testimony) of your obedience to this ordinance:

“Jesus Christ is the Lord of my life, I am dead to the practice of sin and wrongdoing, and I am born again and have new life in Christ by faith.”

We invite each and every member of World Overcomers to be baptized. You may have already been baptized, and if that is the case, you don’t need to be baptized again, unless there are some underlying situations that may have drawn you away from Christ. Here is how you know you need to be baptized:

- a. You have never been baptized before,
- b. You were baptized but it was before you were saved, or
- c. You were saved, baptized, but you fell away from God and are now recommitting.

Baptism is held the 3rd Wednesday of every other month. You may register for the next Baptism class online at worldovercomers.church.

3. Believe in and Trust the Leadership of World Overcomers Christian Church

At World Overcomers we aim to serve you the best we possibly can. We have a leadership team that is here to help you develop and grow in your walk with Christ and develop into the balanced believer God has called you to be. However, in order to do that we need you to believe in and trust in the leadership that has been established in our church. The Bible states that agreement is the place of power (*Amos 3:3*) and we want you to agree and be submitted to our leadership.

4. Commit Your Resources: Become a Faithful Tither & Giver

We expect each member of World Overcomers to be faithful givers. We are not a church that begs for money, so trust that the reason we want you to tithe is not personal or self-serving. Our desire is that you walk in wholeness and balance in every area of your life, and as the church, we stand on God's Word and believe what he says about tithes and offerings.

What is tithing? Biblically, the tithe is the term for the 10% of your gross income. Your gross income is the income you earn before the deduction of taxes or other contributions such as savings and medical insurances.

Here are some scriptures on tithing that you can use as a reference.

Malachi 3:10 | Leviticus 27:30 | 2 Corinthians 9:6-7

Not only does your tithe bless you, but it blesses the Body of Christ through this church. You are the reason for World Overcomers, and it is you who will take us to the even higher level that God is calling us to as we continue to establish the work of God through the church. We trust that you are a faithful tither and giver.

Other Services Include:

Marriage Ministry

We offer Premarital courses for couples that are recently engaged or who are in a serious relationship moving toward marriage. The Premarital course is a six-week course offered in the early spring and late fall of each year. After the course is completed, our Pastors on staff can officiate your wedding. Engaged couples are encouraged to be married within a year of taking the Premarital course.

For those individuals who are already married, we offer marriage counseling that can include private sessions during **WOCC** office hours. There are also couples fellowships that are hosted periodically throughout the year.

Baby Dedications

The arrival of a new baby is a joyous occasion for the entire family. Dedications are a ceremony where the believing Christian family dedicates their child back to the Lord. The parent(s) and family agree before the Lord to commit their child to God's will and will raise him/her under His way. (See: *1 Sam. 1:11*) In order for your baby to be dedicated, he/she must be at least 6 months- 5 years of age (The baby must be able to hold his head up on his own).

Baby dedications happen every 2nd Wednesday of every month in the main sanctuary during our Core Service.

Funerals & Bereavement

When someone you love is dying or has died, we are here to provide spiritual support and assistance with funeral and memorial service plans.

OUR BELIEFS

At World Overcomers, we believe:

The Scriptures, Old and New Testaments, are God-breathed: that by the supernatural influence of the Holy Spirit, the biblical writers wrote the divine, trustworthy, and authoritative Word of God, the only rule of faith and practice (*Matthew 5:18; 24:35; 2 Timothy 3:16; 2 Peter 1:20-21*).

In the one true God who has revealed Himself as eternally existing in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit; distinguishable yet indivisible (*Deuteronomy 6:4; Matthew 28:19; Luke 3:21-22; 2 Corinthians 13:14*).

In the Incarnation: the deity of Jesus of Nazareth - that He is Lord, the Son of the living God, was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the virgin Mary, and is truly God and truly man (*Luke 1:26-35; John 1:1, 14, 18; Isaiah 7:14; 9:6; Philippians 2:5-11; Revelation 1:7-8; 22:12-13, 16*).

Mankind was originally created by God in His image, fell into sin through disobedience, marred God's image, plunged all of creation into depravity, and made it impossible for man to save himself (*Genesis 1:27; 3; Romans 5:12*).

In the Substitutionary Atonement: that Jesus Christ died on the Cross for our sins, obtained eternal redemption for us, was buried, and was raised bodily from the dead on the third day, fulfilling Old Testament prophecy, and appeared to His disciples (*Isaiah 53; Luke 24:1-3; Acts 1:1-3; 2:22-36; 1 Corinthians 15:1-8; Hebrews 9:12-14*).

Jesus of Nazareth ascended bodily into heaven, was exalted to the right hand of the Father, and that He will literally and physically return the second time for the Church (*John 14:2-3; Acts 1:9-11; Philippians 2:9-11; 1 Thessalonians 4:13-5:11; Hebrews 9:28*).

The personal salvation of the repentant sinner, by grace through faith is the finished work of Christ on the Cross, produces the "Abundant Life" (*Isaiah 53:4-5; Matthew 8:16-17; John 10:10; 19:30; Acts 17:30-31; Romans 5:1-2; Ephesians 2:8-9; 1 Peter 2:24*).

In water baptism by immersion, as an obedient response of the believer to the command of the Lord (*Matthew 28:19; Acts 2:38; 19:1-5*).

In the baptism with the Holy Spirit, the promise of the Father for empowering believers to witness about Christ (*Luke 24:49; Acts 1:4-8; 2:1-4*).

Speaking in other tongues is an initial manifestation of the Baptism with the Holy Spirit that every believer has a right to expect, and that the charismatic gifts of the Holy Spirit are to operate in the local church until Jesus returns (*Acts 2:4; 10:44-46; 19:6; Romans 12:6-8; 1 Corinthians 12:8-10; Ephesians 4:11*).

In the local church as the primary instrument of God in the earth to disciple men, and to establish the kingdom of God through prayer, fellowship, and the ministry of the Word (*Matthew 28:19-20; Acts 2:42-47; 6:4; 20:28; Ephesians 4:11-16; 2 Timothy 2:2; Hebrews 10:25*).

On the "Last Day": Jesus will return in the "Second Coming", there will be a resurrection of the dead including the righteous and the wicked, and after judgment the righteous will be rewarded, but the wicked will be punished (*Daniel 12:2; John 5:28-29; 6:39, 40, 44, 54; 11:24; Acts 24:15; 1 Corinthians 15:51-52; 1 Thessalonians 4:16-5:11; Revelation 20:11-15; cf. Matthew 25:31-46*).

SERVING

There are serving opportunities for almost everyone. Check out the following ministries to find your place to serve here at WOCC.

ANDY THOMPSON MINISTRIES (Retail)

The media kiosks are the primary source for packaging and distributing the dynamic Word of God ministered at World Overcomers. Some of the daily responsibilities include: customer transactions and support; inventory supply ordering stocking and distribution; and online product sales, processing and shipping.

BANQUET SERVICES

Banquet Services provide food and beverage services for volunteers and staff of WOCC each Sunday for breakfast and/or lunch. They also provide these services for special events and meetings. No cooking experience is required to serve.

CONNECTION TEAM

The Connection Team is comprised of welcome greeters, guest services and VIP. Our main objectives are: to be a bridge for newcomers and regular attendees to access BOTH information and relationship and responsive to both the immediate needs and short term needs of the church and its people. Greeters welcome all our guests, direct and escort them, develop initial relationships, and hand out bulletins. Guest Services is where we can have an open dialogue with guests regarding WOCC functions. VIP greet everyone but especially the First Time Guests and hand out welcome to WOCC packets.

ENVIRONMENTS

Environments is designed to support every aspect of the ministry. This team will assist before, during and after every service or event held at WOCC. This includes moving chairs faster than a speeding bullet; more powerful than a forklift; jumping tables in a single bound! Environments is the force behind the ministry! Come join the strongest team here at World Overcomers... we're always seeking a few good men.

EVENTS TEAM

The Events team was built to address the need of WOCC events. This team is staffed by hard-working, energetic, personable and flexible volunteers. Some roles may include but are certainly not limited to: Organizing, Decorating, Event Setup & Teardown, Planning, Cleaning, Greeting, and Serving Food. This is a great area for members whose schedule does not allow them to commit to a set monthly volunteer schedule but they still want to be involved.

GATEKEEPERS TEAM

Dependability. Loyalty. Hospitality. If you are a man who exemplifies these three major characteristics, you are just the man we need. Gatekeepers provide support for all areas of the ministry, it is crucial that you are able to lead and follow; while displaying a servant's heart. Gatekeepers are responsible for maintaining order throughout the service by directing and seating people in an orderly manner and administering the offering.

MEDIA & PRODUCTION

The goal of WO Productions is to share God's Word, with excellence, using audio and video technology, creativity and numerous facets of multi-media production to expand the audience of Pastor Andy and World Overcomers, while empowering each person's growth spiritually and innovatively in a team environment. Positions we have available are: Camera Operators, Motion Graphic Designers, Video Editors, Video Engineers, Media Operators, Audio Engineers, Directors, Multi-Media Presentation Techs, Stagehands, Still Photographers, Video Librarian, Information Technology Techs, and Light Engineers.

MEDICAL TEAM

The Medical Team provides rapid on-site emergency first aid to anyone with a medical emergency while at WOCC or during select offsite WOCC activities. The Medical Team consists of certified medical professionals including Medical Doctors, Physician Assistants, Nurse Practitioners, Nurses, Pharmacists, Emergency Medical Technicians and other healthcare professionals. On-duty team members will be alerted by an electronic communications device or by WOCC staff for immediate response to illness

or injury on church property. The medical care we provide is designed to stabilize or maintain the patient, until the arrival of local Emergency Medical Services (EMS).

ONEL1FE (Youth)

ONEL1FE is an experience designed to help 6th- 12th graders know God. Through an inviting atmosphere, intense worship and a Word presented on their level; we create an environment that makes church a fun and exciting place they will not want to leave. Volunteers at ONEL1FE 'Bring It' every week! Smiles, funny stories, pure-energy and love for God are the banners that help our staff build lasting relationships with our students and each other. From shaking hands at the door, serving pizza at the snack bar, playing the Xbox or PS4 with a 6th grader to praying with a student; there is always somewhere to make an impact at ONEL1FE.

OVERCOMER KIDS (Children's)

Overcomer Kids provides ministry to children in two parts. One area is designed to minister to children from ages 6 months to 5 years. The other area is designed for children from ages 1st to 5th grade. Overcomer Kids has numerous volunteer opportunities such as: Bible Story Teachers, Registration Attendants, Service Coordinators and Lead Teachers and assistants. We would like to provide you the opportunity to experience the reward of teaching, assisting and equipping our children.

OUTDOOR ENGAGEMENT TEAM

The Outdoor Engagement team is responsible for traffic control and picking up members and visitors throughout our parking lots. They are often the first face new visitors will see. Each van and shuttle driver will have an exact route that they follow to pick and drop off members and visitors before and after each service on Sundays.

PROJECTS OF HOPE

At World Overcomers Christian Church, we like to roll up our sleeves and get involved in community activities beyond the walls of our sanctuary and encourage our members to do the same. Throughout the year, you can find us in local neighborhoods spearheading food drives, WOCC Toy Drive donations, or volunteering in local shelters.

WO WORSHIP

WOCC worship leaders, choir, band and praise team members all work together to produce an atmosphere filled with the presence of God. The goal of the Music Ministry is to provide a sanctified environment that prepares members' and visitors' hearts to receive the Word of God. Current Music Ministries include The Band, World Overcomers Choir, Generation Joshua, and The Praise Team.

PRAYER MINISTRY

The Prayer ministry's purpose is to gain access to the presence of the Lord and to get results from praying. Divided into prayer time and instructional time, the prayer ministry gives time for meditation and personal prayer with inspirational music. We've learned that time in His presence solves many problems that seem insurmountable during a busy week. This hour is designed not only to be meditative but produces an attitude that expects results.

PRIMETIME (Adults Ages 45+)

Come discover the latter end blessings! There are some blessings that young people are just not qualified to receive. They are reserved for people like you and me who have age and experience. I call them "latter end blessings." (Deut. 8:16 KJV) However, to experience these blessings, designed with us in mind, we prime timers must think differently than most of our peers. Primetime Ministry is a ministry that is designed for like-minded individuals that are ages 45+ to come together and become active at World Overcomers Christian Church. Every 3rd Saturday of each month, Primetime has an event where we enhance our knowledge of technology, and display the different gifts and talents that God has given us. This is a ministry that will make sure that we are not lost in a rapidly progressing world.

WHY GIVE?

Tithing and the Old Testament

“Isn’t tithing an Old Testament Law that doesn’t apply to us today?”

Not exactly. Tithing came about long before the Old Testament Law, and yet was also supported by Jesus in the New Testament. It started when Abraham gave a tithe of all his bounty to honor God:

“And blessed be God Most High, who delivered your enemies into your hand.” Then Abram gave him a tenth of everything. (Genesis 14:20 NIV)

Abraham’s grandson Jacob followed suit and vowed to do the same, honoring God. The tremendous stream of blessing resulting from their tithing moves us this very day to follow the same example:

“Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You give a tenth of your spices—mint, dill and cumin. But you have neglected the more important matters of the law—justice, mercy, and faithfulness. You should have practiced the latter, without neglecting the former.” (Matthew 23:23 NIV)

“I Don’t Trust Preachers With Money. Should I Still Tithe?”

Yes, keep doing good. You are giving to God. He will honor your sacrifice. Consistent giving prospers the giver like seed does the farmer. The abuse of finances by some should not cause you to “torpedo” your own blessing. Give as unto the Lord.

“Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for men, since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving.” (Colossians 3:23 NIV)

Also, remember that God, not Man, is the “blesser,” the one who brings the increase:

“Now he who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will also supply and increase your store of seed and will enlarge the harvest of your righteousness.” (2 Corinthians 9:10 NIV)

“What If My Spouse Is Not Saved?”

You are only responsible for what you have in your hands. However, one should not assume their spouse won’t allow it. Time should be taken to discuss the subject together with sensitivity and prayer. In any event, make the decision to tithe whatever portion of money comes into your hands.

“Wives, in the same way be submissive to your husbands so that, if any of them do not believe the word, they may be won over without words by the behavior of their wives, when they see the purity and reverence of your lives.” (1 Peter 3:1-2 NIV)

No matter your role in the relationship, husband or wife, God says that if you continue to do good and follow after His commands, your spouse will be won over by your fervent faith and your well-doing.

Membership Code of Ethics

___ I will conduct myself in a manner that does not bring reproach on the cause of Christ, World Overcomers Christian Church, and the Senior Pastor. In consideration of *1 Thessalonians 5:22*, I will abstain from all appearances of evil.

___ I will subscribe to the doctrinal beliefs of World Overcomers Christian Church and will not communicate anything that contradicts the WOCC belief statement. (*1 Corinthians 1:10, Amos 3:3*)

___ I will refrain from participating in gossip, murmuring, and complaining about church leaders and policies. I will address my concerns to the appropriate parties in a civil and Christ-like manner. I will not allow any volunteer, member, or church leader to complain about church leaders or policies in my presence. (*1 Corinthians 1:10, 2 Corinthians 12:20*)

___ I will treat every visitor, member, volunteer, and leader in a way that is Christ-like and show the love of Christ in my dealings with each person.

___ I will take ownership of my church.

___ I will support the church with my tithes and offerings.

___ I will maintain a cheerful disposition, live in the spirit of faith, and rebuff those who endeavor to introduce negative attitudes into World Overcomers Christian Church.

___ I will live a separated Christian life.

___ I will be faithful to attend regular church services.
